

MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These Terms and Conditions form the basis of the contract through which the British In Vitro Diagnostics Association (BIVDA, we, or us) will deliver a service to you as a BIVDA member (you). On becoming a member of BIVDA you are automatically agreeing to these Terms and Conditions, and you are providing us with the appropriate consent to handle your information in accordance with the Data Protection Act.

Membership Subscriptions

- Membership subscriptions run for a period of one year payable annually in advance. BIVDA operates a system of calendar year billing.
- Membership fees are revised annually, and members will be notified of any fee changes in writing via their subscription renewal notice.
- BIVDA is able to offer a facility for members to pay instalments via a standing order arrangement, but the balance of the membership invoice must be paid off by the end of the calendar year.
- Membership subscription payments not received within three months of the due date will
 result in the membership being considered lapsed, and all services will be suspended; with
 seven days written notice given.
- A member may resign membership at any time by sending written notice to the Chief Executive, but members are required to give six months' notice of resignation and will be liable for six months subscription charges if notice is not given.
- A member who ceases to operate in a manner qualifying the organisation for Full Membership shall no longer be eligible to be a Full Member of BIVDA, but may be eligible as an Associate Member.

Use of the BIVDA logo is permitted if you are a BIVDA member, and we have granted you express permission.

Variation

We may change these terms and conditions at any time upon giving you 14 days prior written notice. The most recent edition of these Terms and Conditions will be binding upon you.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms and Conditions are governed by English law. If any court or competent authority decides that any of the provisions of these Terms are invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable to any extent, the Term will, to that extent only, be severed from the remaining Terms, which will continue to be valid to the fullest extent permitted by law.
