- India is among the fastest growing health economies in the world and among the top 3 healthcare markets in terms of incremental growth to reach USD 638 Bn by 2025.
- The digital healthcare market is estimated to reach USD 485.43 Bn by 2024 across tele-health, m-health, remote diagnostics & healthcare analytics.
- India is the largest export market for UK medical goods worth over USD 150 million across high tech medical imaging equipment, instruments, implants and consumables.
- Healthcare education and training is a growing segment with demand for e-learning specialist training courses, certification programmes, Continuous Professional Development courses and upskilling courses in cardiology, surgery, orthopedics, pediatrics and oncology.
