
The End of Transition Period has left a legacy of further milestones over the next few years, which will need to be factored into HMG and industry planning.



^{*} Products of Animal Origin: Will impact on suppliers importing products such as infant formula etc. Finished licensed medical products are exempt.

^{**} Export Health Certificates: Wholesalers will need to complete EHCs to move products containing animal products. Significant issues with complying with this requirement that are likely to make it difficult to move these products in the current 12-24hr window wholesalers operate under. Products affected primarily infant formula, nutritional supplements and medical foods/feeds.

^{***} EU Medical Devices Regulation: On 26th May a key new requirement is that businesses who act as importers will need their name and registered place of business on the packaging or documentation accompanying the imported device which will create regulatory divergence between GB and NI.

⁺Trader Support Service (TSS) requires <u>Simplified Frontier Declarations</u> (SFDs) and <u>Supplementary declarations</u>. SDs for movements made in January and February will need to be completed by 4th March.
